### Riding Apparel

We were heading to Bike week in Pennsylvania. I rode my bike, Linda and our daughter followed me in the family wagon. I kept getting a gut feeling something was about to happen. I pulled over at Front Royal Virginia and put all my leathers on. We stopped for gas and a break in Berkley Springs West Virginia. The station attendant was a Harley Enthusiast and we chatted for a while. I couldn't get over how friendly people were to bikers in this town. The attendant said "don't kid yourself a biker was killed here about a month ago."

At eleven- forty-five we hit the road again. I woke up at two-thirty in Winchester Virginia trauma center with a fractured skull and concussion, but not a sign of road rash. Why? The station attendant was an EMT. He said he ran to me and found that I had no pulse and was not breathing. Something told him to cut my helmet strap and leathers from around my neck. We'll call that something his six senses anyway I'm glad he listened to it. He said I made a big hasp and started back breathing.

Linda said the EMT cut all my clothes off except my briefs and Harley boots. That's not the good part before leaving home Linda cut a pair of her panty hose off at the knees and said "wear these, when your feet swell it will give your feet more room." Can you picture a preacher laying on the high way in nothing but his fruit of the looms, Harley boots with panty hose out the top of his boots I'm glad I was unconscious. I can still hear my mother say when I was a child and started somewhere "son change your under wear, you never know when you will get in a wreck."

Let's see what lessons are to be learned from all this. 1. Leave the panty hose wearing to the Ladies of Harley. 2. Always listen to that sixth sense. Unless it's the one that says you can take on the biggest guy in the club. That one lied to me and laughed when I found out. 3. If you are going to crash it works great to have an EMT on the scene. See you in the wind.
